



Timber Creek High School Project Graduation Contract

Guidelines

1. Project Graduation will be held at the new Main Event in North Ft. Worth, 2601 Presidio Vista Dr. on May 28th from Midnight to May 29th at 6:00 a.m. Check in starts at 11:45 pm. No one will be admitted after 1:00 am.
2. It is a "lock-in" that includes unlimited bowling, laser tag, gravity ropes, video game play, billiards, food and drinks. Dress comfortably - shorts, t-shirt and socks for bowling.
3. Tickets earned for early registration or participation in a PG fundraising event will be distributed at check-in and may be used to enter in drawings for thousands of dollars in prizes and gift cards. Guests are not eligible for prizes or gifts.
4. Students must attend the full event to be eligible for prize drawings and gifts. If a senior chooses to leave early, there is no re-admittance and will forfeit all prizes.
5. Transportation to and from Main Event is the responsibility of each student or parent/guardian. Parents are encouraged to drop off and pick up seniors as they will be extremely tired.
6. Leave all valuables at home. TCHS Project Graduation and Main Event are not responsible for damaged, lost or stolen items.
7. Project Graduation is an alcohol, drug and tobacco free event. Students and guests who appear to be under the influence of any prohibited substance will not be permitted to participate in Project Graduation. The use of any these substances during the celebration will result in immediate removal and a parent/guardian will be notified. Local police officers will be on site to deal with inappropriate behavior or violations of the law.
8. Photographs or video taken at the event may be used in the future for Project Graduation promotions.
